

DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING OUTPATIENT CENTRE INFORMATION FOR WALK-IN CT SCAN PATIENTS

A clinician has ordered a CT (Computed Tomography) scan for you to be performed at Misericordia Health Centre. A CT scan is a medical test that uses X-rays to take images while you lie on a table. The table moves along into the machine that looks like a doughnut.

Walk-in appointments are available:

- Visit the Diagnostic Imaging Registration Desk located inside Misericordia's 99 Cornish Avenue entrance during these times:
8 a.m. – 7 p.m. Monday-Friday
8:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Saturday
Closed statutory holidays

Your wait time will depend on how many other patients are also waiting.

Preparations for CT scans

- Avoid wearing metal objects in your hair or on your clothing
- All jewelry, including any body piercings, must be removed from the area which you are having scanned

Parking

- Parking is available in the 25 Sherbrook Street parkade or in metered parking across from the parkade. Limited free parking is also available within walking distance of Misericordia Health Centre
- From the parkade, walk across the 2nd floor overpass and follow signs for Diagnostic Imaging on the first floor

Transit
