Long-Term Care

Misericordia Health Centre provides long-term care with team approach that makes its residents feel valued and part of a special community.

Misericordia Place | 204-774-6581

Misericordia Place is connected to Misericordia Health Centre through an enclosed walkway. The personal care home offers 100 residents private rooms they can personalize and make feel like home. Residents can enjoy the company of others for meals and take part in recreation and social programming.

PRIME, a health centre for seniors | 204-789-2400

Providing care to seniors age 65 or older in the Winnipeg community with chronic complex problems posing high risk of admission to a personal care home, emergency department or hospital.

Scheduled Respite

MHC offers 16 scheduled respite beds, providing relief to families who care for a dependent senior.

Transitional Care Unit | 204-774-6581

MHC's 111 bed Transitional Care Unit (TCU) serves patients who require complex social and medical support for a limited period of time before transitioning home with community services or to a personal care home, supportive housing or elsewhere such as Hospice.

Team Approach

Residents of Misericordia Place and Transitional Care Unit clients are cared for by an interprofessional team that includes physicians, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, health-care aides, dietary support, a social worker and numerous dedicated volunteers.

A recreation facilitator plans social and recreational programs that include activities such as bocce ball outdoors in warm weather, shuffleboard, cards or knitting groups.

Volunteers help residents to chapel, deliver newspapers, assist in sending and receiving emails or simply share a good book by reading to residents.

A spiritual care associate is available to provide spiritual and emotional support.

Residents also have access to specialized services such as eye care, urgent care and rehabilitation services.
