How donations make a difference:

\$25: Pediatric dental kits

More than 900 pediatric dental surgeries are performed at Misericordia each year! Children receive take-home dental kits filled with products to help care for their teeth and picture books to help them understand dental health in a fun way!

\$100: Music & Memory supplies

Music is a shared activity that fosters connection, even virtually, between a non-verbal resident and their loved ones. Music supplies, like an MP3 player, enrich long-term care residents' lives immensely.

\$250: TCU winter care packages

MHC's Transitional Care Units care for clients who may be marginalized or in vulnerable situations. When clients transition to new safe spaces, winter care packages are offered with items tailored to each client to help them stay healthy – like bus passes, meal vouches and warm clothing.
