COVID-19 outbreak on MP3

Over the weekend, we declared a COVID-19 Outbreak on MP3. At this time, we have three residents who have tested positive. We will continue to monitor all residents. All residents on the south side are in isolation, and we have increased staffing to assist with extra precautions and PPE protocols.

Although we restricted all MP3 visitation on the weekend due to the outbreak, we feel we are in a position to welcome designated caregivers back between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. At this time, general visitation to MP3 will remain suspended.

All designated caregivers entering an outbreak area must wear the PPE that is required for that resident. Visiting will take place in the resident's room only. Entering an outbreak area does come with risks to everyone. Staff will assist you with the PPE required, and we remind everyone of the importance of careful hand hygiene.
