Misericordia Place is about to begin participating in a research study Counting What Counts: Assessing Quality of Life and its Social Determinants Among Long-Term Care Residents with Dementia. The study is a joint University of Manitoba and University of Alberta study assessing the quality of life (QoL) of long-term care residents with dementia, as well as important resident and facility characteristics that may affect resident QoL, such as resident health, social support, and facility size and ownership.

We look forward to the study results and learning from other Personal Care Homes across Canada.
