Updated COVID-19 guidance

- Masks are no longer required for outdoor visits
- Eye protection is no longer required for designated caregivers, although some exceptions apply
- Residents can now identify up to FOUR designated caregivers, who can visit two at a time
- One exciting update is that residents' outings are now allowed with guidelines in place. I know our recreation team is excited to be planning a variety of outings, such as bowling, with the funds raised during the Foundation's *Around the World: The Manitoba Edition* campaign.
