Visitation updates

As of today, **proof of vaccination is no longer required for designated caregivers or general visitors.** All visitors will continue to be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and we ask that you do not come to Misericordia Place if you are experiencing symptoms or have been exposed to the virus. Only one visitor at a time for a resident.

No appointment is necessary for designated caregivers, who may visit at any time. General visitors may attend by appointment between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.. Please call reception between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. weekdays at 204-788-8440 to make appointments. If general or designated visitors wish to visit two at a time or do not want to visit in a resident's room, they can book an appointment for the nun's suite.

Mass in the chapel returns

Sunday in-person mass in our chapel will resume on March 6. To avoid mixing units, residents will attend on a three-week unit rotation. Due to physical spacing requirements family members cannot join mass at this time. All units will also show a mass at 1:30 p.m. each Sunday.
