Vaccines

We are pleased to report that COVID-19 and flu vaccines have been given to all interested residents. As new residents arrive we will continue to offer vaccines to help keep everyone safe.

Bracelets

We are in the process of ordering new name bracelets for residents. This is the second attempt in my time at Misericordia Place to get the bracelets correct—the first one was very hard for staff to put on. These ones are like medical alert bracelets with just name and date of birth on the front and facility name and phone number on the back. We are required to ensure that all residents have a bracelet. We are just in the process of sizing the ones we purchased.



Stevenson Funding Phase two:

We have received our second-phase of funding for new positions at MP. We will be adding night health-care aides, MP1 health-care aides and a float health-care aide position. We are also adding a clinical resource nurse so we have clinical support every day.
