MINOR INJURY AND ILLNESS CLINIC: COMING SOON

Likely you've noticed our Ambulatory Care area is awash with activity! We're busy renovating to prepare for the integration of a new Minor Injury and Illness Clinic (MIIC)!



What is a MIIC? Minor Injury and Illness Clinics offer primary health-care services and support for minor health-care concerns that may not require a trip to an Emergency Department or Urgent Care Centre. Minor injuries and illnesses may include:

- Suspected fractures or sprains
- Burns and more severe rashes, sores or skin infections
- Cuts that won't stop bleeding
- Severe sore throat/ear or cough, worsening respiratory infections

- Sudden and severe back pain
- Eye irritation or redness
- Persistent fever (seek care same day if the fever is over 101.5 F or 38.6 C and lasting over eight hours)
- Minor to moderate rashes or infections
- Lab and X-ray services
- Painful hemorrhoids or perianal infections

Misericordia – which has a long and rich history of meeting community needs – is excited to expand our campus of care to include this MIIC

Along with making improvements to the space, we're starting to install new equipment and hire staff to support the clinic.

The clinic will open in the new year, offering care seven days a week from 7:30 a.m. to 10 p.m.

This is great news for West Broadway, Wolseley and surrounding downtown neighbourhoods and we are pleased to partner with our government to best serve Winnipeg patients.

CAFETERIA CONSTRUCTION IS UNDER WAY

The proposed cafeteria renovations you heard about in September are officially in motion.

As you might recall, the new seating area will feature booth seating, a glass-walled conference room, cozy tables and chairs, and a fresh new colour scheme to tie it all together.

The renovation work will continue in phases so stay tuned. We're excited for MHC staff to enjoy this long over-due refresh!
