YOUR AWARENESS = SAFETY

Keeping everyone safe at Misericordia is an on-going process from locking down staircases to installing panic buttons to changing exterior entrance times.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- 1. When arriving at and leaving work, be aware of your surroundings. If you see anything even slightly suspicious, please contact Security—call the Information Desk by dialling "55" internally or 204-774-6581 externally.
- 2. If you are coming in or going out a secure door such as a card access door, make sure the door secures behind you (just like at home!) and strangers don't come in with you.



It is with great sadness we share news from Montreal of the passing of Sister Monique Lallier, Superior General of the Misericordia Sisters, notably on our Misericordia Mission Day – January 27, 2024.

Sister Monique passed away peacefully at the age of 86. She spent 62 years of religious life with 20 of those years as Superior General.

May her soul rest in peace and our prayers be with her family and those saddened by this loss.

Some staff may remember Sister Monique from her visits to us here at Misericordia Health Centre. She always enjoyed observing compassionate care at MHC and receiving our annual reports of innovation, responsiveness and community!
