

DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING OUTPATIENT CENTRE INFORMATION FOR WALK-IN CT SCAN PATIENTS

A clinician has ordered a CT (Computed Tomography) scan for you to be performed at Misericordia Health Centre. A CT scan is a medical test that uses X-rays to take images while you lie on a table. The table moves along into the machine that looks like a doughnut. The Diagnostic Imaging Registration Desk is located inside Misericordia's 99 Cornish Avenue entrance.

CT-scan walk-in appointment hours:

The department opens at 7 a.m. with walk-in CT appointments beginning after 8 a.m.

- Monday to Friday: 8 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- Saturday: 7:45 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.
- Closed statutory holidays

Please be aware appointments are not guaranteed, and your wait time will depend on how many other patients are also waiting.

Preparations for CT scans

- Avoid wearing metal objects in your hair or on your clothing
- All jewelry, including any body piercings, must be removed from the area which you are having scanned

Parking

- Parking is available in the 25 Sherbrook Street parkade or in metered parking across from the parkade. Limited free parking is also available within walking distance of Misericordia Health Centre
- From the parkade, walk across the 2nd floor overpass and follow signs for Diagnostic Imaging on the first floor

Transit
