Re: New visitation guidelines at Misericordia Place

Pandemic Response System: elevated to Level Orange (restricted)

As of today, Monday, September 28, Winnipeg has been elevated to Level Orange (restricted) in the #RestartMB Pandemic Response System. We have adjusted visitation guidelines accordingly.

NEW: visitation updates

As per the direction of Public Health, the following changes will be in place for a minimum of four weeks (two incubation periods of COVID-19.)

Designated family caregivers may continue to visit loved ones indoors, but only ONE visitor at a time. Indoor visits with general visitors are suspended; outdoor visits continue.

Please speak to reception, your loved one's resident care manager or myself if you have any questions about the new changes in visitation.

Non-essential services restricted

Hairdressing services at Misericordia Place have been suspended.

Visitation reminders

- Do not visit if you are ill or have any flu-like symptoms.
- Sanitize your hands before entering. Wash your hands frequently with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
